

2023 Campaign Results

Data from the 2023 American College Application Campaign, as reported by state campaigns, indicate that:

- Over 9,400 high schools hosted a College Application Campaign event nationally.
- More than 489,000 seniors submitted at least one college application during 2023 College Application Campaign events.
- Roughly 1,400,000 college applications were submitted during events.

Because not all data are reported, we know these results are conservative. To date, 4.7 million students have been served, submitting over 8.7 million college applications since the campaign's inception in 2005.
